#### Other Business

Don reviewed with Marla, roles and responsibilities, warrants, financial statements

Charles Butler gave a review of Food service operations, including breakfast, and lunch programs deficits. We discussed the Harvard Pilgrim grant. He gave a handout on food program which showed it brings in 80% of expenses. Handout shows \$850,000 in income with a little over a million in expenses. USDA has required a larger portion of food with more required fruits and vegetables with all meals. Participation in lunches 50%, breakfast is 24.6%. RDMS and South Schools free breakfast increasing in participation to help cover costs, being allowed to go to classroom to eat. There will be a State review of the program starting in December and into January. Darryl asked, if student doesn't do hot lunch, do they have cold lunch? This is unknown and a good question to follow-up on.

Lew discussed the audit progress. Auditors will be in Monday and Tuesday next week. We will discuss FY 13 fund balances in the near future including reporting errors in Health Insurance, and ongoing deficit errors.

June 2013 Food account \$80,000 line item doesn't cover actual costs overages.
